Exhibition "Rumals of Chamba: Embroidered Expressions of Pahari Women"

The Embassy of India in Belgrade and the National Assembly of Serbia, in association with Indian Council for Cultural Relations, are organizing an art exhibition "Rumals of Chamba: Embroidered Expressions of Pahari Women" at the House of National National Assembly, Nikola Pasica Square 13.

The exhibition is based on explorations, revivals and innovations using diverse stitches and textures in Pahari (hills) embroidery. The products like partitions, coverlets, wall hangings and apparels have been embroidered on diverse range of fabrics with natural dyed yarns based on traditional themes. The exhibition is conceptualized and curated by Dr. Rohini Arora, academician and design consultant who has researched, revived and worked with traditional embroiderers.

Exhibition will run from 1-7 November 2018. It is open to public and entry is free. Visitors must book a prior appointment with the Education Department of the Parliament to view the exhibition. Registration can be done by any of the following ways:
