Seven Indian high school students participate in 25th International Conference of Young Scientists (ICYS) Belgrade, 19-25 April 2018

H.E. Mrs. Narinder Chauhan, Ambassador of India to the Republic of Serbia attended the Inaugural of the 25th International Conference of Young Scientists (ICYS), which was held in Belgrade on 19-25 April 2018 at Sports Center Sumice, Belgrade, and organised by the Belgrade-based institutions, the Regional Center for Talented Youth and Institute for Gifted and Talented Children and Youth.

Seven students from India participated in the Conference in the fields of physics, computer science, environmental science and life science. Three students from India won special awards for their research papers in physics, computer science and environmental science. The Indian team was also top rated by other participants for the best cultural presentation of their country.

The International Conference of Young Scientists is a special type of individual competition of research papers in several scientific disciplines, including physics, mathematics, computer science, environmental science, life science, for 14 to 18 year-old secondary school students from all over the world. ICYS has gained notable participation from across continents (Europe, Asia and America). Every year the conference is organised by a different host country and relevant institution, on a rotating basis.

The aim of the conference is to encourage scientific and social exchange amongst young scholars from all over the world, as well as build stronger ties between young scholars and their countries.
